

## Warrior Band Boosters General Meeting Minutes

This is approximately \$10,000 in gross income. Our costs are significantly lower this year, at approximately \$3,000. We expect our net profit to be approximately \$7,300; this is factoring in the reimbursement from the SFWGA. Last year we made \$2,000.

### **FUNDRAISING UPDATE**

We estimate we made \$6,900; last year we raised \$6,350. We may be charged for a couple of incidents. The inventory system changed and every day we were short. (Counting problems?) Not everyone stopped cooking at the 6th inning; we had lots of leftovers. We had great weather and a lot of fun.

We estimate the hourly rate earned will be \$9.13, compared to \$8.41 last year.

We had 36 volunteers this year; last year we had 43. We had two stands, which required 18 people at each stand. There were some days we needed 21 people. Thank you to the many adults and students who worked!

Adrienne Avallone and Lea Anne Rivera are likely taking over this fundraiser next year. Bonnie encouraged a "Pay It Forward" promotion for seniors to work for underclassmen who are not old enough to participate.
