OFFICER/COMMITTEE REPORTS

FINANCE REPORT – Tracy Mallette

We are about \$6,000 in debt. We have \$7,800 outstanding in Spirit of Jupiter Fair Share.

We REALLY need everyone to pay their Fair Share, as we will have payments due for charter buses, UHauls, etc. once competitions start.

Cheesecake sales have not been credited to fundraising accounts yet.

CONCESSIONS REPORT – Debbie Wiley for Rose Lynch

We have earned a net profit of \$3,304.03 for 6 games to date:

- 1 preseason JHS varsity game
- 1 JHS varsity game (home opener)
- 2 JHS JV games (rain at one)
- 2 JCS games (rain/called game at one)

We are doing concessions for these remaining games:

- 4 JHS varsity games
- 2 JHS JV games
- 2-3 JCS games (competition conflict with one of the games)

Comparison to 2014: \$5,524.61 in 6 games

- 3 JHS varsity games
- 3 JCS games

SO we still have the potential to make a lot of money this year. Our current year budget estimated we will make \$7,500.
