FRIDAY, OCTOBER 21 - SENIOR NIGHT FOOTBALL GAME AGAINST PALM BEACH CENTRAL HS

CALL TIME 5:45 PM

EAT DINNER BEFORE CALL TIME: Students will be permitted to leave the stands ONLY to use the restroom. No eating during the game.

Call time is **5:45 PM** - EVERYONE in full uniform and ready to play.

SENIORS and their escorts should be at the south end of the end zone by 6:15 PM to enjoy some refreshments and line up. The ceremony starts promptly at 6:40 PM.

Instrumentalists should wear/bring:

Black compression shirt

We plan to distribute black compression shirts to girls sometime this week. If they don't arrive in time, girls should wear a dark, snug shirt under their bibbers. IF they arrive, please plan to wear the new compression shirt at MPA on Saturday; i.e. wash the shirt Friday night if you wear it to the game!

Black compression shorts

Girls who do not have compression shorts can wear "sliders" or other snug shorts that do not show lines in the bibbers

All-black long socks

Show hair

No eating or drinking in uniform except water. **Spirit students may NOT eat at concessions.**

After the game, students are expected to *properly and neatly* hang their uniform back on the hanger and in their garment bag. Shoes can be stored in the back pocket of the garment bag, NOT inside the bag with the uniform. Please HANG your shako wrap; do NOT store it in your shako box. **All parts of the uniform should be taken home when students leave the band room Friday night.** Please do not leave your uniform in the band room!
