

Winter Percussion Families - Please read this important information from Winter Percussion Liaison Cynthia Carrino.

Hello Winter Percussion Students/Parents!

The first competition of the Winter Percussion season is this Saturday, January 21 at John I. Leonard High School. A detailed schedule will be forthcoming.

In the meantime, we need to make arrangements for student transportation. As the Winter Percussion group is substantially smaller than the full marching band, we rely on parent volunteers to transport the students to and from the competition.

All parents who volunteer to drive any student other than their own MUST be registered as a volunteer in VIPS and RAPTOR at the Jupiter High School front office. You CANNOT transport students unless you are a registered and approved volunteer.

If you are willing to transport students and/or volunteer at the event, please send me your name, your child's name, how many students you can transport (including your own), your phone number, and your email address by 7:00 p.m. Tuesday, January 17.

In addition to being a registered volunteer, parent drivers must complete the attached form and submit with it a copy of their drivers' license and proof of auto insurance. PLEASE turn in this paperwork by Thursday, January 19. You can place it in the wire inbox in the band room (just inside the main doors where all paperwork goes) OR you can put it in the Fair Share box for better security.

Of course you may drive your own child to the competition. Please let me know if you are planning on doing this so I know that I do not need to make arrangements for your child.

Please be advised that students may not drive other students. However, students may drive themselves if they choose to do so.

Generally, we meet at an off campus site (as the gates to the school are usually locked) on the morning of the competition. We then make sure that each student needing a ride is assigned to a parent volunteer. At the conclusion of the competition, you will need to return to Jupiter High School (the gates will be unlocked) where the students will unload the equipment truck.

If you volunteer to drive, you are not required to remain at the competition for the whole day; however, if you choose to do so, we always need volunteers to chaperone and/or assist with moving the equipment to and from the competition floor.

And please do not forget that you must be registered with the school if you plan on driving any student other than your child. AND you must turn in the attached paperwork.
