STANDS TUNES

ALL wind instrument players should have received a Stands Tunes packet when they signed out of band camp on Thursday, July 20. If you don't have a packet, the music is available in Charms in the "Spirit of Jupiter Music 17-18" folder (under the Handouts & Files icon) by instrument and by title. You MUST be logged in to Charms to see this music.

NOTE: Percussion students (battery and front ensemble) did not receive music, just the list of tunes to be played. Stands tunes music for Percussion is improvised.

All students should have their own flip folder and lyre. These can be purchased online or at a local music store. Be SURE to get a lyre that fits your instrument! It is STRONGLY recommended that you write your name in silver Sharpie on the flip folder.

Students should be practicing this music; it will be played at Warrior Welcome. Only the Jupiter HS Fight Song and Star Spangled Banner should be memorized.
