

Subject: Spirit Uniform Fitting Begins Monday 8/7

***This email does not apply to color guard members!***

### **ATTENTION INSTRUMENTALISTS:**

We will start fitting **returning Spirit of Jupiter students** for bibbers (black marching band overalls) on Monday, August 7. Please bring with you to camp:

- **YOUR COMPRESSION SHORTS** to try on with the bibbers. Bring them EVERY DAY to camp until bibbers are assigned to you.
- **YOUR GARMENT BAG** to store the bibbers in when they have been assigned to you.

**NEW Spirit of Jupiter members**, should be fitted starting on Tuesday (hopefully).

- IF you have compression shorts (any color), please bring them with you to camp until you are assigned bibbers. (Compression shorts are also called “sliders” for girls.) **All instrumentalists are required to have a pair of compression shorts (preferably black).** The band may have some extras for sale - stay tuned.
- Bring a garment bag or large garbage bag to help protect the bibbers assigned to you between the band room and home. **ALL NEW Spirit of Jupiter members will receive garment bags when they come in (mid to late September).** If you have been in Spirit of Jupiter previously, you will not get a new garment bag, but you can order a new garment bag if you need one. *Watch your email for ordering instructions.*
- We will take measurements to assist us with fitting the jackets when they arrive.

ALL students fitted with bibbers will receive:

1. **Uniform Care Instructions** and
2. 2 copies of the **Marching Band Uniform Contract** explaining the responsibilities and replacement costs. One copy is for you to keep and the other must be signed by a parent and **returned by Wednesday, August 16.**
