The Spirit of Jupiter is marching in the 41st Annual JTAA Holiday Parade THIS Sunday, December 10.

Schedule:

11:00am – Meet at band room to pick up equipment (if needed)

11:30am – Band room is locked to meet for parade

12:00pm – Meet at Subway parking lot at Banyan Street and Old Dixie Highway

1:00pm – Parade starts

2:00pm – Parade ends (approximate time)

2:30pm – Meet back at band room to unload/drop off equipment

Students must provide their own transportation to the parade start and from the parade finish.

The Spirit of Jupiter is in position #24 in the parade.

Parade Rehearsal

Remember there IS a parade rehearsal this Wednesday, December 6 from 3:00 pm to 5:00 pm.

What to Wear:

All instrumentalists should wear their **full competition uniforms**.

Color Guard members should wear festive holiday clothing with SOLID black leggings or a festive skirt AND tan performance/dance shoes.

Holiday hats can be worn instead of shakos. SHOW HAIR IS NOT REQUIRED.

Music:

The band will be playing measures 1-24 of *Sounds of Angels* during the parade.

Memorize this music NOW! It is available in Charms in the "Spirit of Jupiter Music 17-18" folder. Look for the file "Sounds of Angels - ALL PARTS."

For the standstill performance, the band will play a portion of The Celestial Project.

Parade Start/Finish Locations:

The **parade staging area** is located by the Subway restaurant near the intersection of Banyan Street and Old Dixie Highway. **ALL BAND MEMBERS MUST BE DROPPED OFF on Orange Avenue** (between Center Street and Indiantown Road) in the marked area between Center Street and Datura Street. Students will walk towards Old Dixie and find the band. (Jupiter Middle and Independence Middle bands meet in the same area.) You will not be allowed on Old Dixie Highway. **The only vehicles permitted on Old Dixie are vehicles that are participating in the parade. No thru traffic!**

The **parade ends** at Bridge Road and Old Dixie Highway. Students will be dismissed from this location. Park in any open area on Bridge Road; there are businesses on the SE corner where you can park if you leave your car there early enough. There is usually parking near the CVS on Alternate A1A also. See the attachment for directions to this area from the parade staging area.

We are also in need of cases of water to keep the kids hydrated during the parade.

Please drop off your donation in the band kitchen on Wednesday before 4:30 pm OR on Saturday between 9:00 am and 9:00 pm (during Winter Guard rehearsal).
