On **Saturday, February 17, 2018**, the Jupiter High School Band is hosting a Florida Federation of Colorguards Circuit (FFCC) competition. More than twenty groups (including our JV and Varsity Winter Guards) will be competing, and we are expected to have a FULL gym of spectators!

We will be running Concessions at this event, and we need YOUR HELP to help defer costs to make this event successful and profitable!

**If a specific brand name is listed, PLEASE PURCHASE THAT BRAND NAME.** We will be selling these items at concessions, so we need to have large quantities of the same items.

ALL donations should be dropped off in the band room kitchen **by Thursday, February 15, 2018**. Please **label your donation with your student's name**, and your student will receive **EXTRA CREDIT** for the **donation**. Drop offs can be done by students during school hours, or the band room will be open after school on these dates/times:

- Wednesday, February 7: 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm
- Thursday, February 8: 2:45 pm to 6:00 pm
- Monday, February 12 - Wednesday, February 14: 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm
